DAY 1

Workshops about tolerance:

1. The word “tolerance” comes from Latin “to tolerate which means to bear, to suffer”
2. Tolerance means to tolerate or put up with differences. It means showing respect for the race, religion, age, gender, opinions, and ideologies of other people or groups.
3. Tolerance is the foundation of democracy and open society, it enables concrete discussion without unnecessary aggression or quarrel. It is an important concept that helps people to live together peacefully.



DAY 5

- Tolerance can be learned by visiting different places where we have the opportunity to interact with art and new people. We do not always understand paintings or literary works, but this does not mean that we should criticize them. The visit to Zawiercie was an opportunity for us to reflect on this theme. The visit to Ogródzieniec, on the other hand, confirmed to us how important it is to take care of the environment every day!



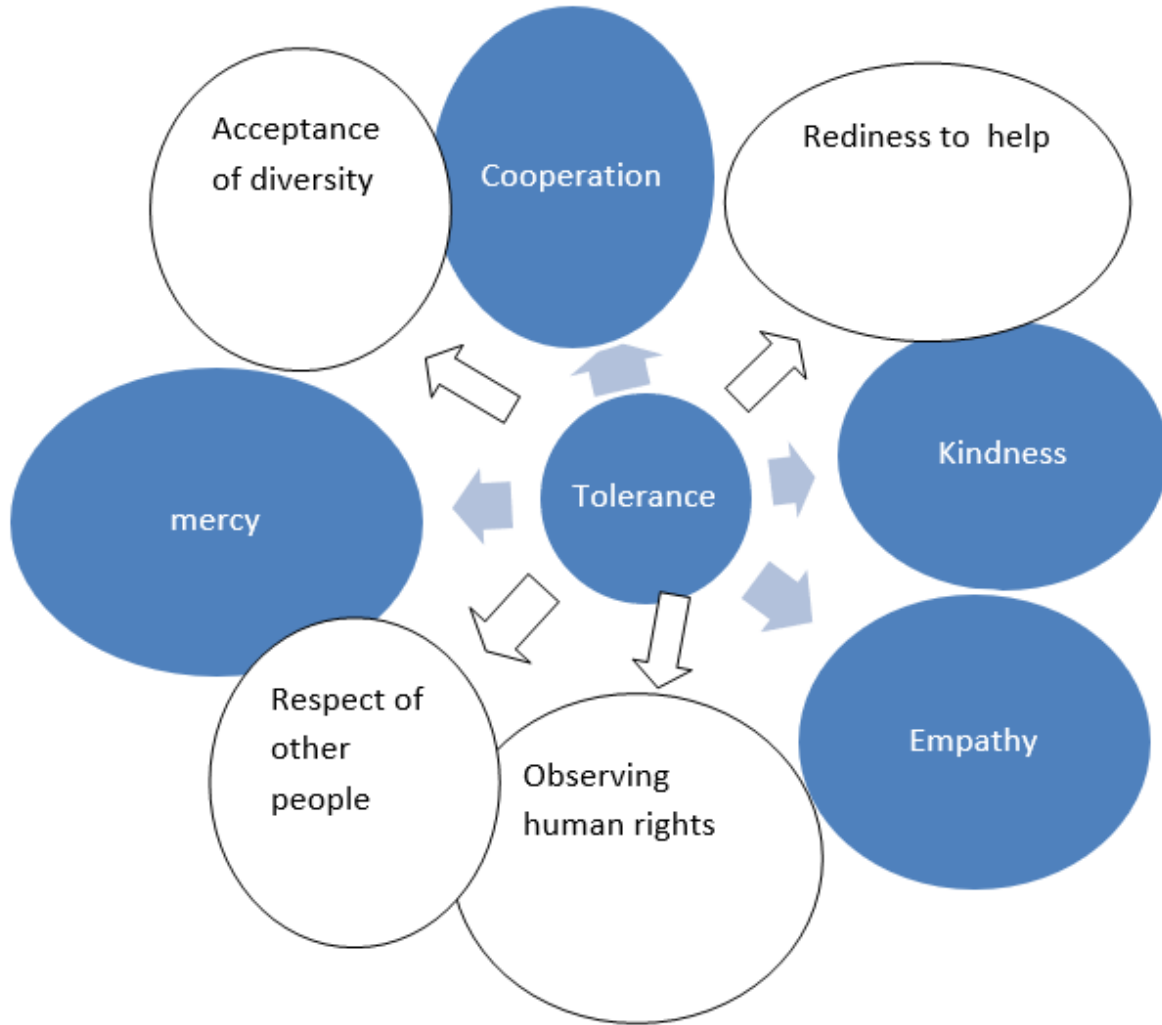
DAY 6
